Course Description

OVERVIEW:

This course is designed for North Toronto students who have either completed or are concurrently enrolled in the Grade 10 Band Course AMI2O1 or AMI2O3. The program will focus on ensemble performance and assess the theoretical and historical knowledge gained through a variety of repertoire.

Performance: Areas covered will include technique (e.g., posture, tone production, intonation, articulation), musicianship, ensembles)

Analysis: Interpretation and reflection of band and small ensemble repertoire.

Listening: In-class listening will include both recorded and live performances. Emphasis will be on analysis of different musical elements.

Assessment and Evaluation

TYPES OF EVALUATION:

Students are evaluated individually in relation to their own rate of progress within a class expectation.

Performance technique: Regular individual assessment will take place to examine progress in posture, tone production, intonation, articulation and interpretation of notation.

Written submissions: Analysis research, self-evaluations, concert reviews, practice logs

Daily performance: Progress, initiative, attendance, punctuality, and responsibility for all music and materials.
