Course Overview

Welcome to Writer's Craft. This senior elective English course aims to expand your imagination, and guide you to explore your creative self. It will refine your abilities to write in many different genres, including memoirs, narratives, articles, screenplays, and poetry. You will learn about potential futures in the fields of freelance writing, journalism, and film.

You must come to class (when in school) prepared with a laptop or padlet, a writer's notebook (journal), a binder (divided into two categories - coursework and response to literature), and a good pen.
