Course Outline for French Grade 10 Academic (FSF2D1/3)
2022-2023

This course aims to strengthen students' speaking, listening, reading and writing skills in French, as well as their critical and creative thinking and collaboration skills and global awareness. Students will become familiar with the French-speaking world in Canada, Europe, Africa and elsewhere and will compare elements of francophone cultures with their counterparts in other cultures.

Text: Theme-and-genre-based units draw on online articles, stories and videos, as well as reference materials developed by teachers in the NTCI Department of Modern Languages, Classics and ESL (distributed in photocopied format).

Evaluations:

Listening and speaking: pair conversations, small-group discussions, listening tests based on authentic texts and videos

Reading: authentic sources such as interviews, articles, etc..

Writing: summaries etc...
